

General Engineering students must meet the following requirements in order to be eligible to declare:

*1. After first semester*

- 12 credits earned at NJIT with a 3.0 GPA
- Earn a B or better in both Calculus I (Math 111) and Physics I (PHYS 111/111a)

*2. After first year*

- 24 credits passed during the first year
- Student maintains a 2.5 GPA
- Student has a C or better in both Calculus I (Math 111) and Physics I (PHYS 111/111a)

This policy applies ONLY to students in the General Engineering program who are interested in the following majors:

- Mechanical Engineering (ME)
- Industrial Engineering (IE)
- Electrical Engineering (EE)
- Computer Engineering (COE)
- Civil Engineering (CE)
- Biomedical Engineering (BME)
- Chemical Engineering (ChE)

Students interested in any of the Engineering Technology (ET) programs should speak with their academic advisor first.
